NOTE:

- i. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- ii. Expenses for meals, books, stationery, calculator and medical allowance have to be met by students' sponsors.
- iii. You are required to report for studies **18th October**, **2022**. All selected applicants must report at the Institute not later than TWO WEEKS after commencement of studies.
- iv. Selected candidates are allowed to transfer from one course to another depending on availability of slots in a preferred programme and possession of required minimum entry requirements specific for the programme. Transfer will be subject to NACTVET directives.
- v. Upon arrival candidates will officially complete the registration process as per the instructions which will be provided. Candidates are required to bring one recent passport size photograph, **originals** and **copies** of all academic certificates, **active result slips**, **or transcripts** and a birth certificate.
