2. You are required to report at TIA Dar es Salaam campus for registration starting from **17<sup>th</sup> October, 2022**.
3. **Fees structure for academic year 2022/2023** for local students is as follows:

Apart from the above costs; NHIF fee of **Tsh 50,400/=** must be paid by students who have not been covered by any health insurance scheme using a different control number from tuition fees.

4. Accommodation is not guaranteed. Where provided, it will be on the basis of first come first served at rental charge of **Tshs. 450,000** per annum payable in lump sum at the beginning of the academic year. **Payment should be made using control number after a room has been secured.**
5. Tuition fee amounting to **Tshs 500,000/=** or above and NHIF fee of **50,400** for those without any health insurance coverage should be paid to enable registration of the candidates. Candidate shall be required to pay **30%** of semester fee to be allowed to attend classes. Candidate should further **30%** to be eligible to seat for Test One. The remaining amount of tuition fee equal to **40%** of semester one fee should be fully paid before commencement of Test Two.
6. Deadline for paying semester one tuition fee is two months after commencement of studies. Candidates are advised to obtain control number before making any payment. Control number can be obtained after logging in into TIA system when conducting online registration. Pay through **NMB or CRDB** banks OR mobile

networks such as M-Pesa, Tigo Pesa and Airtel Money using provided control numbers. NHIF fee is paid with a different control number.

**A. Bank: Follow these steps to pay**

1. Record your control number and visit NMB or CRDB to make payments
2. Upon your arrival at any of the banks shown above, provide the control number to a teller to process the payment

**B. M-Pesa: Follow these steps to pay**

1. Dial \*150\*00#
2. Select 4 (Pay Bill)
3. Select 5 (Government Payment)
4. Select 1 (Control Number)
5. Enter Reference Number (Enter Control Number Here)
6. Enter amount (Enter the amount you want to pay)
7. Enter Password (Enter your account Password)
8. Enter 1 (To agree)

**C. TIGO Pesa: Follow these steps to pay**

1. Dial \*150\*01#
2. Select 4 (Pay Bill)
3. Select 5 (Government Payments)
4. Enter Reference Number (Enter Control Number)
5. Enter amount (Enter amount you want to pay)
6. Enter Password (Enter your account Password)

**D. Airtel money: Follow these steps to pay**

1. Dial \*150\*60#
2. Select 5 (Make Payments)
3. Select 3 (Government Payments)
4. Enter amount (Enter amount you want to pay)

5. Enter Reference Number (Enter Control Number)
6. Enter Password (Enter your account Password)

**NOTE**

- i. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- ii. Expenses for meals, books, stationery, calculator and medical allowance have to be met by students' sponsors.
- iii. You are required to report for studies on **17<sup>th</sup> October, 2022**. Selected applicants who will report two weeks after beginning of studies will not be accepted for registration and will be advised to apply afresh for another academic year.
- iv. Upon arrival a candidate will have to officially complete the registration process as per the directions which will be provided. Candidates are required to bring one recent passport size photograph, **originals** and **copies** of all academic certificates, result slips, or transcripts and a birth certificate. Any other relevant professional or academic certificate can also be presented.
