Congratulation for being selected to join TIA!

I am pleased to inform you that you have been selected for a **ONE YEAR** Post Graduate Diploma Course inand you are required to report at **TIA Dar es Salaam Campus** as from **19th October, 2026**. Selected applicants who will report **TWO WEEKS** after beginning of studies will not be accepted for registration.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The following instructions are provided to guide you. You are therefore requested to read them very carefully before you come to the Tanzania Institute of Accountancy.

1. TIA CAMPUSES

Tanzania Institute of Accountancy has eight campuses strategical located in Dar es Salaam, Singida, Mwanza, Mbeya, Mtwara, Kigoma, Zanzibar and Tonga. The Dar es Salaam serves as the Institute's headquarter.

2. MEDICAL EXAMINATION

You will be required to undergo medical examination which will be conducted at the respective campus during registration period. Cost for medical examination is **Tsh.15, 000/=**. This is not inclusive in the Institutes tuition fee.

3. REGISTRATION

You will be required to register formally before commencement of classes in order to become a student of the Institute. **Any document, proof of identity or information requested from a candidate is for facilitating student enrollment.** The following are requirements for registration:-

a) Academic Documents

Original certificates and transcripts of your general education (Form IV and Form VI, Diploma, Balor degree, Advanced diploma, professional qualification (where applicable), and any other relevant documents which were presented with your application.

b) Proof of identity

Bring with you the following documents: -

- Four passport size photographs-To ensure uniformity, passport size photo services will be available at the campus for every student at the cost of **Tsh.3000/=**
- **Study permit (for foreign student)**
- Birth certificate

c) Payment or evidence of payment of fees.

A receipt or deposit slip as evidence for payment of:

- Semester one tuition fee and other contributions for the respective programme
- National Health Insurance Fund (if you are not a member of any Health Insurance Fund)

d) Other relevant documents (These can be downloaded from www.tia.ac.tz)

- Duly filled in Registration Form- can be downloaded from www.tia.ac.tz
- Medical examination form –from the medical experts operating at the respective campus during registration period.

4. TUITION FEES FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

You will be required to pay the required fees as per fee structure of your course presented to you with the application forms. No student shall be registered unless he/she has paid the required fees. Fees paid will not be refunded. Details of annual fees are provided for local and foreign students respectively. Students are encouraged to pay the full annual fee at the beginning of the academic year.

Tuition Fee for foreign students is US DOLLARS 1300 per year, NHIF Fee 50,400/= inclusive.

a) NHIF fee of TZS. 50,400 for those who have not been covered by any health insurance scheme should be paid using different control numbers which will be obtained at a respective campus to enable a candidate to proceed with registration.

b) Candidates are advised to obtain control number before making any payment (**different control numbers for payment of tuition fee, hostel fee and NHIF fee**). Control number will be generated after logging in with your admission number into TIA student information management system in the process of online registration. Candidates will make payment through **NMB or CRDB** banks OR through mobile networks such as **M.Pesa, TIGO Pesa and Airtel Money**, using obtained control numbers.

5. MODE OF TUITION FEE PAYMENT

Tuition fees can be paid in full amount or in installments. 70% to be paid in Semester One and 30% in Semester Two as indicated below:-

Post Graduate Diploma Programmes (First Year) A/:

Semester One

During Registration TZS 1,453,000/= (*Registration fee include NACTVET Quality Assurance, Transcript, Graduation Gown, ADMISSION COORDINATION FEE, APPLICATION FEE TIASO, TZS.) and TZS. 50,400 for NHIF to be paid direct to NHIF*).

B/: Semester Two

Semester two tuition fee is 552,000/=

6. STUDENTS ORGANIZATION

Students at TIA are automatically members of Tanzania Institute of Accountancy Students' Organization (TIASO). Through this organization, students communicate to the Institute matters affecting their welfare. As per TIASO Constitution, students are required to pay TZS 10,000/= per year as a compulsory membership fee. TIASO also has a number of professional associations which are students' professional associations affiliated to TIASO in accordance to various

professions. Students will be required to subscribe to these professional associations depending on their programmes.

7. LEARNING RESOURCES

Expenses for books, stationery, calculator and medical allowance have to be met by students' sponsors.

8. CAFETERIA SERVICES

Meals are provided at campus on cost basis. Students are responsible for paying for their daily meals.

9. ORIENTATION WEEK

The schedule for orientation will be provided to you on your arrival for registration. All students have to participate fully in the orientation programme.

10. CHANGE OF NAME

No change of names will be allowed during the course of study. Students will be allowed to use names which appear in their academic certificates only.

11. CHANGE OF PROGRAMME

Transfer is allowed **internally** (from one programme to another within the campus) or **externally** (from one campus to another or institution to another). Transfer is done at the beginning of an academic year as per regulators admission calendar.

Transferring from one academic programme to another will be allowed only where the student has the required admission criteria for the academic programme for which transfer is being sought and if there is available vacancy in that programme.

12. SPORTS AND GAMES

The Institute has facilities for out-door games such as football, basketball, volleyball, netball, athletics and other various games. The Institute participates in the national sports competition. Thus all students are expected to participate in at least one form of the games or another depending on one's interests. You are advised to come with your own sports and games outfits.

13. DEFERREMENT OF STUDIES

Students who have been selected but fail to join the Institute for any reason cannot defer the admission to the next year. Such students need to apply afresh for the following year.

14. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

The Institute requires its students to behave in a professional manner at all times. In order to portray this professional image, students must, at all times, dress in a manner that reflects professionalism and respect. Moreover, at any time each student is expected to conduct himself/herself in such a manner that may not contravene examination regulations, library rules and any other lawful stipulations issued from time to time by the Institute's Management. As a student you should take particular note of the Almanac as it is the most reliable source of timings for each of the important academic events that concern members of the TIA community.

14. ACCOMODATION

The institute has limited number of rooms for accommodation, rooms are provided on the basis of first come first served at annual rental charge of TZS. 450, 000/- (**Dar es salaam- campus hostels**) and TZS. 250,000/- for Mbeya, Singida and Mtwara Campuses payable in lump sum at the beginning of the academic year. Before located a room, student should complete **Payment using control number**.

15. REPORTING

Dar es Salaam Campus is located at the junction of NELSON MANDELA AND KILWA ROAD. On your arrival to Dar es Salaam, candidate may use Public or Private transport direct to TIA at KURASINI Area. For more help, contact 0739 77 77 98, 0767 77 77 46 and 0620 77 77 44.
